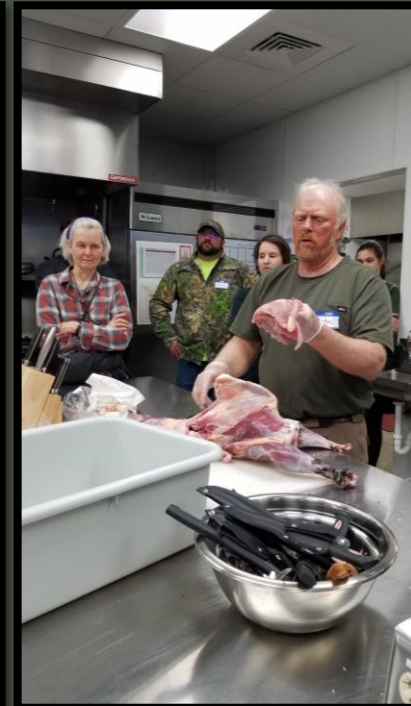


# HUNT FOR FOOD - TURKEY

Learn to hunt ethically for your own locally sourced meat, participate in a Wisconsin tradition, and take part in conservation!  
Specifically for adults with no or limited experience.



## Class 1: Introduction to Turkey Hunting and Gun Handling

## Class 2: Turkey Biology, Hunting Tactics, and Where to Hunt

Learn about the turkey life cycle and its preferred habitat. Relate this information to discover proper tactics for turkey hunting. Finally learn about how to find places to turkey hunt near you.
